ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA


1. Average Flame Time (after flame) after removal of the flame source may not exceed **4.0 seconds** for length or width
2. Char length may not exceed **6.0 inches** for any individual specimen.
3. When a part of the char length is melt away due to heat from the flame source and not from propagating flame, the sample submitted meets the requirements of Title 19 – California Code of Regulations, Section 1237 and 1237.1 for fabrics weighing less than 4 oz./sq.yd. These specimens shall be marked with an asterisk (*) next to the char length.
